**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve purchase of APX6000 radios and accessories, utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract #DIR-TSO-4101, for Information Technology, with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for \$122,932.50.

**BACKGROUND**

DIR vendor, Motorola Solutions, Inc., was contacted and requested to submit pricing for APX6000 radios and accessories under DIR Contract #DIR-TSO-4101.

The offer received from Motorola Solutions, Inc. meets all specifications and is acceptable to Information Technology.

The Juvenile Detention division moved their communications to the regional public safety network last year with an initial purchase of seventy-five (75) radios. This purchase of twenty-five (25) radios will serve to provide communication resources that were not addressed at that time as well as the expanded courts and detention facilities that were recently added.

Motorola Solutions, Inc. offers the products through the State of Texas DIR Contract #DIR-TSO-4101.

The DIR contract expires June 22, 2024.

DIR's cooperative contracts program is open for state and local government in accordance with Texas Government Code Title 10, Subtitle B, Chapter 2054, Subchapter A, Section 2054.0565, Use of Contracts by Other Entities, "(a) The department may include terms in a procurement contract entered into by the department, including a contract entered into under Section 2157.068, that allow the contract to be used by another state agency, a political subdivision of this state, a governmental entity of another state, or an assistance organization as defined by Section 2175.001. (b) A political subdivision that purchases an item or service using a contract under this section satisfies any other law requiring the political subdivision to seek competitive bids for that item or service".
