COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2022-173, Annual Contract for Counseling and Education for Veterans Treatment Program, for the first and final optional twelve (12) period at the same contract terms.

BACKGROUND

On September 20, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139192, awarded RFP No. 2022-173, Annual Contract for Counseling and Education for Veterans Treatment Program, for Criminal Courts Administration, to the following vendors:

The awards were based upon the evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained an option to renew for one (1) additional twelve (12) month period.

This contract is used to divert Justice-Involved Veterans (JIVs) from the traditional criminal justice system and partner with local vendors to provide them with the treatment services needed to lead a productive and law-abiding lifestyle; reducing recidivism, improving mental health recovery, and enabling successful reentry into the community.

The vendors notified Purchasing in writing that they will extend the same contract terms through October 5, 2024. Criminal Courts Administration notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendors and want to renew.
